

Erasmus+ KA1 REAL IT, 2020-1-RO01-KA102-078788



During the period 15.06.2021 - 6.07.2021, 16 students from LTIB participated in a mobility in Paphos, Cyprus, within the Erasmus+ KA1 REAL IT, 2020-1-RO01-KA102-078788, financed with the help of the European Commission. The project is responsible for the identified needs within the consortium formed of six schools from the NE region of Romania: "Gheorghe Vrânceanu" National College, Bacău(leader), "Costache Negri" National College, Târgu Ocna, "Roman Vodă" National College, Roman, "Ion Borcea" Theoretical High School, Buhuși, "Vasile Alecsandri" Theoretical High School, Săbăoani, "Ferdinand I" National College, Bacău.

The purpose of the project is to increase the quality of education of the students by helping them develop their professional and personal skills in a real work environment, in order to orient them to an IT career.

Within the mobility, the students did a three- week internship, learning the steps of making an e-commerce site. The cultural programme included Greek lessons, visits to a few archeological sites in Paphos and trips to: Limassol, Aphrodite's Rock, Baths of Aphrodite and the Kourion Amphitheatre.



The project had a positive impact on the participants, who learned how to work and communicate in a multicultural context. The students developed skills that help them to choose the right career and job in another country. The project also helped raise the prestige and the quality of the participating institutions from the project and it had a positive impact locally, through dissemination activities and sharing what they learned with the other students from other local schools and with other colleagues. They also participated in round table discussions, a dissemination activity where they made a presentation on their experience within the Erasmus project to the local economic agent, education institutions, parents, other students and teachers.



At the end of the Erasmus mobility the students came back with wonderful memories, new friends and a lot of new information and experiences gained throughout the 3-week practical activities.
